



Statement of Support to the Health & Social care Professional (HSCP) (Registered Physiotherapists, Radiographers, Radiation Therapists, and Optometrists)) vaccinators to supply and administer COVID-19 vaccines as part of the Health Service Executive (HSE) COVID-19 vaccination programme.

The HSE COVID-19 vaccination programme commenced in December 2020. The Statutory Instruments No. 698 of 2020, No. 81 of 2021 and No. 245 of 2021 identify the Health & Social care professionals (HSCP) as one of the professions that can administer the COVID-19 vaccines, subject to the approval of an education programme by the relevant professional body concerned.

We are happy to support HSCP vaccinators in administering COVID-19 vaccines under the HSE master medicine protocols for COVID-19 vaccines which the Chief Clinical Officer, HSE and Director of National Health Protection, HSE approve.

The COVID-19 master medicine protocols are developed by the HSE in accordance with the National Immunisation Advisory Committee (NIAC) immunisation guidelines for Ireland.

**NOTE:** HSCP Vaccinators must have attained the professional qualification, training and competence requirements as listed in Section B document for HSCP vaccinators in order to be eligible to administer COVID-19 vaccines using the HSE master medicine protocol for COVID-19 vaccines.

To administer the COVID-19 vaccines HSCP vaccinators must be familiar with the

# <u>Section B: Information Specific to HSCP Vaccinators (Registered Physiotherapists, Radiographers, Radiation Therapists, and Optometrists) for the administration of the COVID-19 Vaccines</u>

Statutory Instruments, No. 698 of 2020, No. 81 of 2021 enables health care professionals (including Registered Physiotherapists, Radiographers, Radiation Therapists, and Optometrists) who are COVID-19 vaccinators as professions that can administer COVID-19 vaccines.

In order to administer the vaccine, HSCP Vaccinators (Registered Physiotherapists, Radiographers, Radiation Therapists, and Optometrists) **must** be familiar with the medicine protocol for the administration of COVID-19 vaccines which is available at <a href="https://www.immunisation.ie">www.immunisation.ie</a>

HSCP Vaccinators (Registered Physiotherapists, Radiographers, Radiation Therapists, and Optometrists) are also encouraged to **complete the Self-Assessment of Competency Form** included in this section and also available at <a href="https://www.immunisation.ie">www.immunisation.ie</a>

HSCP Vaccinators (Registered Physiotherapists, Radiographers, Radiation Therapists, and Optometrists) **must** have attained the professional qualification, training and competence requirements as listed below in order to be eligible to administer COVID-19 using the HSE master medicine protocol for this vaccine.

The HSCP Vaccinators (Registered Physiotherapists, Radiographers, Radiation Therapists, and Optometrists) must have completed all of the following:

- 1. Be a Registered Physiotherapist, Radiographer, Radiation Therapist, or Optometrist, on an active register maintained by CORU
- 2. An approved *Basic Life Support for Health Care Providers Course* within the last two years (i.e. Irish Heart Foundation (IHF))
- 3. Initial National Anaphylaxis Education Programme for Health Care Professionals accessible on <a href="www.HSELanD.ie">www.HSELanD.ie</a> followed by a two hour classroom based skills workshop. Recertification is required every two years by completing the on-line National Anaphylaxis Education Programme for Health Care Professionals accessible on <a href="www.HSELanD.ie">www.HSELanD.ie</a>
