A detailed and comprehensive policy is in place in line the COP for use of Physcial Restraint. A named person carries out training for AMHU staff members. Components of training and education, include trauma-informed care, rights- and gender-based approaches, postive behavioural support.

Local reducing restrictive practice involve service user in two day and five day MDT debrief.

A statement about the approved centre's compliance with the code of practice on the use of physical restraint

The AMHU was not compliant with the MHC Code of Practice on the Use of Physical Restraint in 2023.

A detailed policy was in place, outlining roles, responsibilities, and training. All episodes of physical restraint were reviewed by the MDT and the persons individual care plan was updated accordingly. All incidents of physical restraint were discussed at individual care plan meetings, local incident meetings.

All episodes of restraint are audited to ensure full compliance with the Code of practice. Each audit is then further cross referenced against the Code of Practice and the St Michael's Unit Policy on Restraint by the St. Michael's Unit Reduction in Restrictive Practice Multidisciplinary Review and Oversight Committee.

The AMHU have a Reduction in Restrictive Practice Policy.

The AMHU Reduction in Restrictive Practice Review and Oversight Committee meet quarterly to review all episodes of restraint to ensure compliance with both policy and Code of Practice.
