Our capability in this area is getting better each year and we are making more and more relevant information available to both staff and the public.

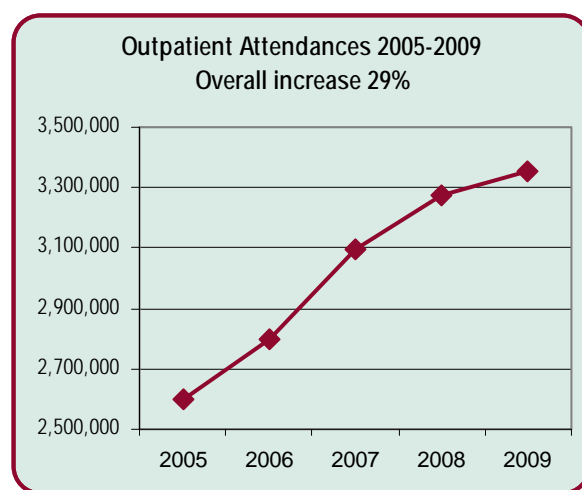
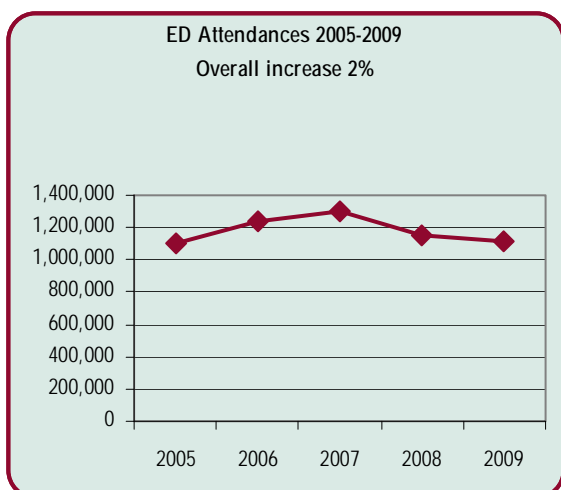
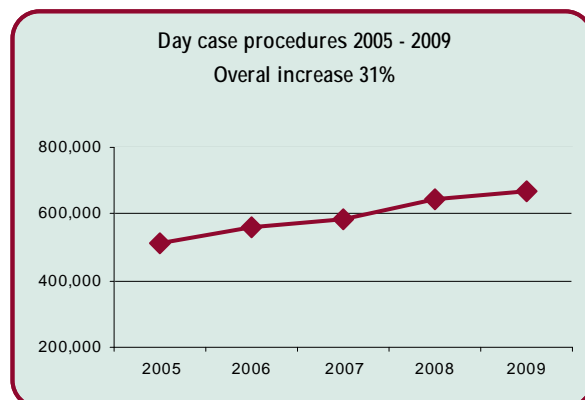
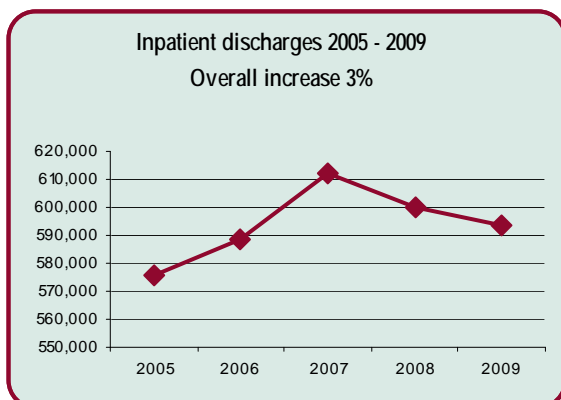
On a monthly basis we now publish HealthStat on the internet. This includes detailed data the public can use to view the performance of their local services and compare them with others around the country.

We also publish the monthly Performance Report which reflects our performance against our annual National Service Plan and includes detailed information on service activity levels, financial and human resources.

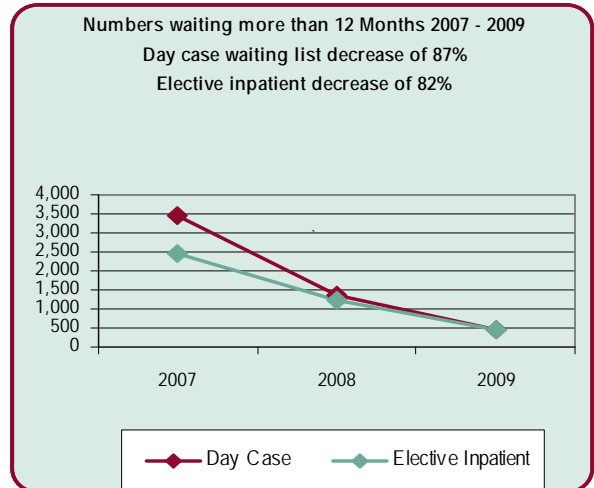
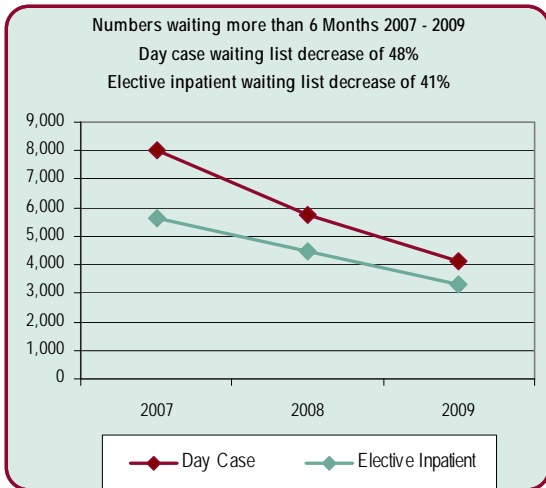
In 2009, we started to publish a six monthly analysis of our performance against our three year Corporate Plan.
