

# Dental Surgeon, Senior Administrative Grade Code 1619

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Dental Surgeon, Senior Administrative** in the Health Service Executive.

# 1. Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition:

## And

(i) Are registered, or are eligible for registration, with the Dental Council of Ireland.

## And

(ii) Have three years satisfactory post qualification experience in the practice of public health dentistry or hospital dentistry or a combination of both.

### And

(iii) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, including a high standard of suitability) and have a satisfactory knowledge of the administrative aspects of the dental services, for the proper discharge of the duties of the office

## 2. Annual registration

On appointment practitioners must maintain annual registration with the Dental Council of Ireland.

## 3. Age

Age restriction shall only apply to a candidate where s/he is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age on the first day of the month in which the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office occurs.

## 4. Health

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

5. <u>Character</u>
Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
