



**Emergency Medical Technician (formerly ICO)**

**Grade Code 3194 (formerly 6133)**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Emergency Medical Technician** in the Health Service Executive.

**1. Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc.**

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition have the following:

(i)	Are currently registered, and maintain registration on the Emergency Medical Technician Division of the Register as held by the Pre Hospital Emergency Care Council (PHECC).
<b>And</b>	
(ii)	Possess the National Qualification in Emergency Medical Technology and the Pre Hospital Emergency Care Council (PHECC) EMT Practitioner's licence.
<b>And</b>	
(iii)	Be the holder of a full Class C1 Driving Licence on application <b>(See note 1 below*)</b>
<b>Or</b>	
(iv)	Be the holder of a provisional Class C1 Driving Licence <sup>1</sup> on application. <b>(See note 2 below*)</b>
<b>Or</b>	
(v)	Be eligible to apply <sup>1</sup> for a provisional Class C1 Driving Licence on application. <b>(See note 3 below*)</b>

**And**

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, (including a high standard of suitability) for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.


**2. Health**

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

**3. Character**

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
