

# General Manager, Care Pathways and Specialist Development

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **General Manager, Care Pathways and Specialist Development i**n the Health Service Executive.

## 1. <u>Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc.</u>

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition have the following:

(i)	Current registration as a PHECC Practitioner (Paramedic level or above).
AND	
(ii)	A qualification at minimum Level 8 on the National Framework of Qualifications maintained by Quality and Qualifications Ireland (QQI) in a field related to clinical practice (e.g. Paramedic/Paramedicine, Quality Improvement, Education)
AND	
(iii)	Have at least two years managerial experience at Grade VII or above within the health service or professional regulatory environment.
AND	
(iv)	A minimum of five years' experience in a clinical practice management role, practice development role, education or quality improvement role.
AND	
(v)	A track record of planning and delivering significant change in a large complex multi stakeholder environment, as relevant to this role.

#### AND

(b) Have the requisite knowledge and ability (including a high standard of suitability and management ability) for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

# 2. <u>Health</u>

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

### 3. Character

Candidates for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
