



**Hospital Ambulance Liaison Supervisor
National Ambulance Service (NAS)**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Hospital Ambulance Liaison Supervisor National Ambulance Service (NAS)** in the Health Service Executive.

1. Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc.

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition have:

(i)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Are currently registered, and maintain registration on the EMT or Paramedic Division of the Register as held by the Pre Hospital Emergency Care Council or be eligible for such registration. <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p>
(ii)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hold an equivalent qualification as validated by PHECC <p style="text-align: center;">AND</p>
(iii)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Have at least 2 years managerial, crisis management and leadership experience in a comparable service context relevant to the role <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p>
(iv)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Have at least 2 years' experience leading and supervising in emergency services including ambulance services relevant to the role. <p style="text-align: center;">AND</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Are the holder of a current full Class C1 driving licence

And

(b) Appointment to and continuation in posts that require statutory registration is dependent upon the post holder maintaining annual registration in the relevant division of the register maintained by the Pre Hospital Emergency Care Council

And

(c) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, (including a high standard of suitability), for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

2. Health

A candidate for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service. The post holder must be capable at all times of undertaking the fundamental duties of this role.

3. Character

Each candidate for and any person holding the office must be of good character.
