**1. Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc.**

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition have:

<b>(i)</b>	A second class honours degree (or equivalent) recognised by The Psychological Society of Ireland in which psychology was taken as a major subject and honours obtained in that subject

<b>(ii)</b>	Be eligible for membership of the Psychological Society of Ireland
<b>And</b>	
<b>(iii)</b>	Fulfil any conditions of the university with regard to entry
<b>And</b>	
<b>(iv)</b>	Have obtained a place on a doctoral programme in clinical psychology in one of the following universities: Trinity College Dublin, University College Dublin, National University of Ireland Galway, University of Limerick, and University College Cork.

(c) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, (including a high standard of suitability and management ability), for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

**2. Health**

A candidate for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service

**3. Character**

Each candidate for and any person holding the office must be of good character
