In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 22 of the Health Act 2004, I hereby approve the qualifications, as set out hereunder, for the appointment and continuing as **Psychology Trainee**, **Counselling in** the Health Service Executive.

1. <u>Statutory Registration, Professional Qualifications, Experience, etc.</u>

(a) Eligible applicants will be those who on the closing date for the competition have:

(i)	A second class honours degree (or equivalent) recognised by The Psychological Society of Ireland in which psychology was taken as a major subject and honours obtained in that subject
And	
(ii)	Be eligible for membership of the Psychological Society of Ireland
And	
(iii)	Fulfil any conditions of the university with regard to entry
And	
(iv)	Have obtained a place on a doctoral programme in counselling psychology in Trinity College Dublin

And

(b) Candidates must possess the requisite knowledge and ability, (including a high standard of suitability and management ability), for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.

2. Health

A candidate for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service

3. Character

Each candidate for and any person holding the office must be of good character
