



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

MICAS Staff Nurse Secondment 0.5 wte x 2 posts

Applications are invited from all eligible post holders who are interested in a **Secondment/ temporary appointment** to the above role.

On the closing date for applications, applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Be registered in the General Division of the Register of Nurses & Midwifery maintained by NMBI
- 1 year's continuous service with their current employer at the date of application.
- Have a minimum of five years' post- registration experience in an acute setting with three years of these within the adult critical care setting
- Have a minimum of 1 years' experience post recognised post-graduate qualification in Critical Care Nursing (or equivalent)
- Up to date ACLS Certification
- Have the ability to practice safely and effectively fulfilling his/her professional responsibility within his/her scope of practice

The MICAS nurse candidate will be a team player with strong critical care skills, critical thinking and collaborative working within a multidisciplinary team.

The Candidate seeking to relocate to NAS CCRS shall be **seconded** for a period of one year for 18.75 hours per week (0.5wte). The Location is NAS CCRS, Laurel Unit, Cherry Orchard Hospital, Ballyfermot, Dublin 10.

AGE

Age restrictions shall only apply to a candidate where he/she is not classified as a new entrant (within the meaning of the Public Service Superannuation Act, 2004). A candidate who is not classified as a new entrant must be under 65 years of age.

HEALTH

A candidate for and any person holding the office must be fully competent and capable of undertaking the duties attached to the office and be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

CHARACTER

Each candidate for and any person holding the office must be of good character.

Applicants should be aware that no panel will be formed from this competition from which any permanent posts will be filled now or in the future.
