Subject: HR Circular 002/2025 - HSE Policy on Fraud and Corruption 2025

Dear Colleagues

I write to advise you that the <u>HSE Policy on Fraud and Corruption</u> has been updated with effect from 13 January 2025, and is now available on the HSE website.

The objective of the policy is to promote a culture that deters fraudulent activity and to facilitate the prevention and detection of fraud and corruption.

The policy is intended to provide direction and assistance to all employees who may identify suspected fraud or corruption. All employees must co-operate with the HSE and other bodies to facilitate the elimination of fraud and corruption by providing information and intelligence, co-operating with investigations, and complying with the policy.

Revisions to the current version of the policy include the role and responsibility of the Audit and Risk Committee.

You are required to ensure that the Policy on Fraud and Corruption is brought to the attention of all employees within your service.

Section 38 organisations are required to have a Code of Governance and Policy on Fraud in place that is consistent with the HSE Code of Governance and this Policy.
