Dear Colleague.

Please note that the following has been agreed in relation to the above:

(a) Incremental progression non-nursing staff:

The Part-time Workers Agreement (1993) allowed for incremental progression to be applied to part-time workers up to a maximum of the (5th) point on the relevant scale on a phased basis.

Following consideration it is proposed that barrier point (5th) as previously applied to part-time and temporary whole-time staff will be amended as follows:

- Staff will be afforded the 6th point as and from their appropriate incremental
 date in 1999 and will subsequently progress through the relevant scale on an
 annual basis consistent with full-time permanent staff.
- In relation to part-time staff they must have a minimum weekly work commitment of 8 hours in the preceding year.

(b) Unsocial hours premium for non-aursing staff

Non-nursing staff will be afforded the premium payment with effect from 5th December 1999 as follows:

Time and 1/6th payment between 6.00pm and 8.00 pm. This payment only applies where the hours 6.00 pm to 8.00 pm are worked as part of a shift of 8 hours or more.

The appropriate letter of sanction is in the process of being issued by the Department of Health & Children.
